TALK about your own legacy. Since this is in the heart of every man, we want you to have a conversation of your own.

Here is what it can look like:

- If you are hosting, be prepared to share briefly (2-4 minutes)
- Open it up for others to share and affirm them as they share
- If anyone seems discouraged, this is a great opportunity to help them get on track
- Pray that God would help everyone to take steps to make their legacy a reality
- Commit to supporting each other. If you are already in group, prepare to talk about it next time you meet. For guys that aren't in a group, plan a time to get back together or perhaps start a group.

ENJOY the rest of the evening and make sure to connect with each guy, see how they are doing, and see if they are in community and serving at Sandals Church.
