

THIS WEEK WITH SANDALS CHURCH KIDS:

Week 5 of *The Visitor* shows Jesus teaching in his home town in Jesus and How to Choose the Good News in Luke 4:14-22. We'll see how Jesus connects his life and ministry to that of the promised messiah who was going to save the world.

ONE THING

Jesus came to bring the good news

We want kids to open their eyes to the idea that Jesus is the promised king from the Old Testament. We'll see that he is the one who will save us from our sin and give us the freedom to have the relationship with God that we long for.

ACTION STEP

I can choose to believe that Jesus saves me

When kids know that they can make their own choice to believe Jesus will free them from sin, their entire lives will change.



THE CONVERSATION

THE STARTER: Tell your kid(s) about a time you chose to believe that Jesus saved you.

1. What do you think the Gospel is?
2. What do you believe about Jesus?
3. Have you chosen to believe that Jesus saved you? Do you want to talk about what that means?



How will you get real about choosing to believe that Jesus saves you? (or how can you put it into practice?)

NEXT STEPS
