

THIS WEEK WITH SANDALS CHURCH KIDS:

Next, we take a closer look at the days after Jesus' death in "The Tomb Raiser" while we read the story of the resurrection in Luke 24:1-34. We learn that Jesus didn't stay dead after the cross but instead came back to life on the third day.

ONE THING

Jesus loves me by defeating death.

We want to guide kids' understanding that Jesus defeated death so we could have a way to eternal life through him.

ACTION STEP

I can be real with God by declaring he is my savior.

When we rightly place God in the ultimate place of leadership and honor in our life he transforms us to become more like him.



THE CONVERSATION

THE STARTER: Share with your child about the time you declared Jesus as your savior.

1. How do we know that Jesus defeated death?
2. What does it mean for Jesus to be your savior?
3. Parents, share about the time you made the choice to make Jesus your savior. Talk about the experience and how it changed you.
