ONE THING

God's plan wins even when I sin.

We want kids to know that no matter how much they mess up, God can always redeem their stories. What God wants will always happen!

ACTION STEP

I can rely on God's grace.

When we sin we can always remember that we have a God who still loves us even at our worst and died to forgive us!



THE CONVERSATION

THE STARTER: *Tell your kids about a time you relied on God's grace. Why did you need his grace? What was the outcome?*

1. *What do you think grace is?*
2. *When have you needed God's grace?*
3. *Does your sin mess up God's plan for you? Why not?*
