

THIS WEEK WITH SANDALS CHURCH KIDS;

Our first week of Connect the Dots looks at *Abram and What in Star-Nation?* as we tell the story of Abram and God's Promise in Genesis 12-17. We'll learn about how God made a man named Abram some wild promises and how Abram had faith that they would actually happen.

ONE THING

God is for me when I believe in him.

We want kids to understand that when we have faith in God, he is always on our side. He promises to protect and bless us, just like Abram.

ACTION STEP

I can be for God by obeying him.

When we choose to obey God, we are showing our faith in him and his plan for us. It helps us grow in trust!



THE CONVERSATION

THE STARTER: *Tell your kids about a time you obeyed God even though it was hard, or you didn't know what the outcome would be.*

1. *Have you ever had to obey and do something hard? What happened?*
2. *Do you believe in God and the Bible? Why?*
3. *Is it easy to believe and obey God? Why or why not?*
