We come to a shift in Week 4 as we dive into Saul for One and One for Saul which depicts Saul's struggle of jealousy and an offer of absolute mercy from David in 1st Samuel 24:1-22. Saul is one lucky guy...

ONE THING

God uses me when I am humble.

We hope kids will learn that God has more room to do amazing things through us when we live in humility and give him credit for all things.

ACTION STEP

I can choose to be humble instead of proud.

Being proud and arrogant can get in the way of relationships - especially our relationship with God. We hope kids will choose humility over pride.

THE CONVERSATION

THE STARTER: Start the conversation by sharing with your child about a time when you chose to be humble instead of proud.

- 1. Who was wearing the robe when David was in the cave? (King Saul)
- 2. What do you think it means to be humble? When have you shown humility/been humble?
- 3. Why do you think God likes it when we are humble?
