ONE THING

Christmas is about God's presence, not presents

We want to guide kids' to recognize God's active presence in their lives, even during the most distracting and chaotic times of the year.

ACTION STEP

I can be real with God by celebrating who he is.

Recognizing Jesus for who he is, the Godman who came to earth in the most unremarkable way just to save us, leads us to true wonder and awe of God.



THE CONVERSATION

THE STARTER: Tell your kids about your favorite Christmas present you've ever received.

- 1. What was your favorite Christmas present? Are presents what Christmas is all about? Why?
- 2. Christmas is really all about how God came to earth to be with us through Jesus. Jesus is still with us even now! What's one thing we can do to help us remember that Jesus is with us?
- 3. Why do we celebrate things? What makes something worth celebrating?



How can you get real about celebrating who God is this week? (or how can you put it into practice?)

NEXT STEPS



Find this logo on the Get Real Guide and read the "Now What" Activity together. Together, make a plan on how you can put into action what your child learned today!
