ONE THING

God is just

We want kids to understand that justice is getting what you rightly and fairly deserve. We also want to guide kids' concept of what real godly justice is and how it means valuing every human equally no matter who they are.

ACTION STEP

I can choose to do good

We want to encourage kids to see the injustices in the world and know that they are called and capable to do good and help others in a way that promotes the same fairness and justice that God gives them.



THE CONVERSATION

THE STARTER: Tell your kid(s) about a time you chose to do good.

1. Can you tell me about a time you chose to do something good for someone else?
2. What do you think justice is?
3. Why do you think God cares about justice?
